

SUPERQUILT

a Super Soft Cuddle quilt for the little Superhero in your life

Fabric Requirements: Featuring "Superhero" from the Robert Kaufman Cuddle Collection

Fabric	Model	Amount
Comic Strip Panel	5RKC-SHCOMICSTR	1 yard
POW!	5RKC-SHPOW	1/4 yard
Superheroes	5RKC-SHSUPERHER	1/4 yard
Charcoal	c3charcoal	1/2 yard
Orange	ribcudorange	1/4 yard
Red *Backing	c3red	1 yard

- » Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin
- » **All seam allowances are 1/2"**
- » Use a 90/14 stretch needle for piecing and quilting
- » A walking foot is extremely useful for both piecing and quilting
- » Lengthen your stitch for piecing and quilting (I use a 3.0)
- » When piecing and assembling, be sure nap goes the same direction
- » When piecing Cuddle fabric, I use a wash-away stabilizer to help control the fabric. Visit my website for more information!

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric	Quantity	Size	
Panel	6	8" x 8"	Fussy Cut 6 Superhero squares from your panel
	2	10" x 36"	Fussy Cut the City Strips
POW!	3	8" x 8"	
Superheroes	3	8" x 8"	
Charcoal	6	3" x 36"	Cut 18" x 36" section first - Cut 3" strips from this
	4	3 1/2" x 18"	Cut from leftover gray section
Orange Ribbon	2	3 1/2" x 18"	



Finished Size: 36" x 52"

Let's Sew:

1. Sew a strip of 3 1/2" x 18" Charcoal Cuddle right sides together with one of your Orange Ribbon Cuddle strips. Repeat so that you have a gray strip on each side of the orange. From this strip set, cut 5 units that measure 3 1/2" x 8 1/2". Repeat with your second orange strip and two gray strips so that you have a total of **9 units** that measure 3 1/2" x 8 1/2".



2. Sew the gray/orange sets from step 1 in between your 8" blocks. Use two blocks from the panel and one each of the POW! and Superheroes fabrics. Each row will have four 8" blocks and three gray/orange strip sets. Repeat with remaining 8" squares and strip sets so that you have 3 Superhero rows that measure 8" x 36". Trim excess if necessary.



3. With fabrics right sides together, sew a charcoal strip (measures 3" x 36") onto the top and bottom of each of the superhero rows. Add City Buildings strips to the bottom of two of these sets. Sew sets together, ending with a superhero row.

4. Make a quilt sandwich with the Red Cuddle (batting optional) and your quilt top. Be sure the nap on your backing goes the same direction as on the front of your quilt. Quilt and bind as desired. A circle quilting pattern that mimics the background of some of the squares and city buildings would be really fun. Wash and enjoy!

Use extra Cuddle fabric to make a few pillows to go with the quilt!
