Cuddle[®] Pet Bed

Approximate Finished Size (Medium) : 21" x 24" x 2½"

Adaptations included for Large Bed (24" x 36" x 4") and Small Bed (14" x 20" x 2½")

Pets l-o-o-v-e the comfort of Cuddle? *Basic pillow construction makes this a fun project for you and you'll be a hero to your pet.*

Fabric Requirements*

- ³⁄₄ yards Luxe Cuddle[®], *Top and Side Bands*
- ³/₈ yards Cuddle[®] 3, *Base*

Suggested Notions

- Batting, Crib Size (45" x 60")
- 20" all-purpose zipper
- Polyester filling, for stuffing
 - Recommended for large bed: Fairfield's Poly-Fil® Basic Pet Bed Insert
- Anti-skid gripper fabric, 2 (4" x 8"), *optional*
- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Felt tip marker or ballpoint pen
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Micro-serrated scissors and/or craft knife
- Long, flower head pins and/or fabric clips
- Basting spray
- Walking foot

Approximate Finished Size: 21" x 24" x 2¹/₂"


DIRECTIONS

• Read Cuddle[®] Basics (on the following page) before beginning.

Right Side Wrong Side

Cuttina

- 1. From Luxe Cuddle[®], cut:
 - 1 (22" x 25"), Top.
 - 2 (2¹/₄" x 20"), Zipper Bands.
 - 2 (3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"), End Caps.
 - 1 (3¹/₂" x 25"), Side Band.
 - 2 (3¹/₂" x 22"), Side Bands.



2. From Cuddle[®]3, cut: • 2 (11¹/₂" x 25"), Base. or 1 (22" x 25") rectangle. _25"-25"

Base Base

- 3. From batting, cut:
 - 2 (25" x 28"), Top and Base.


Assembly

Complete the Base

- 1. With the nap going in the same direction, sew the Base sections together along the 25" edge.
- 2. Fingerpress the seam open.

Add the Batting

- 1. Spray baste wrong side of the Top. Smooth onto a batting piece.
- 2. Use a 4x4mm zigzag to stitch around the edge.



4. Add batting to Base. Trim and tack batting.

Base (Right Side) **Optional:** Topstitch anti-slip rectangles to Anti-slip

Prepare the Zipper Band

the Base.

- 1. Baste long sides of the Zipper Bands together. Finger press the seam open.
- 2. Use basting tape to position the zipper along the inner seam.

Note: While not absolutely necessary, double-sided basting tape makes inserting the zipper *much easier.*

- 3. With the wrong side of the zipper facing up, sew first one side and then the other side of the zipper to the Zipper Band.
- 4. Remove the basting stitches.
- 5. If necessary, trim zipper tape even with the end of the Band.
- 6. With naps going down, attach the End Caps to either end of the Zipper Band.

For the utmost in washability Using the dimensions of the pet bed, make and stuff a muslin liner. Easy to insert. Easy to remove for washing the bed!

Complete the Band

When sewing the Band seams, begin and end $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge. Backstitch at each end.

1/5" 22" Band

25" Band

Top

- 1. With naps going in the same direction, sew the Bands together in the following order: • 22" / 25" /22" /Zipper Band.
- 2. In the same manner, join the final ends to make a loose circle.

Attach the Band to the Top

1. With nap going away from the Top, pin the seams of the Band

to the corners of the Top, opening the $\frac{1}{2}$ " to turn the corner.

- 2. Pin each corner, then pin at the midpoint of each side. Double pin between these points.
- 3. Sew Band to the Top.

Cuddle[®] Basics

- 1. Seam allowances are $\frac{1}{2}$ unless otherwise noted.
- 2. Use a felt tip marker or ballpoint pen to trace appliqués or mark measurements on reverse side of Cuddle[®]
- 3. Cut Cuddle[®] with a rotary cutter, craft knife, or scissors.
- 4. To remove loose fibers, shake (do not tug) cut pieces or put in a no-heat dryer with a damp washcloth for a few minutes
- 5. Sew with polyester thread in the top and the bobbin.

Finishina

- 1. In the same manner, pin the Base to the Band. Pin the seams to the corners, then double pin the sides.
- 2. Sew Band to the Base.
- 3. Turn bed right side out. Open the zipper and stuff as desired.

Make a Bigger (or smaller) Bed! Here are the measurement changes.

For a 24" x 36" x 4" Bed, cut: Use a 24" zipper

- 1 (25" x 37") Top.
- 1 (5" x 37") Side Band.
- 2 (3" x 20") Zipper Bands.
- 2 (7¼" x 9½") End Caps.
- 2 (5" x 25") Side Bands.
- 2 (13¹/₂" x 37") Base.

For a 14" x 20" x 2¹/₂" Bed. cut: Use a 14" zipper

- 1 (15" x 21") Top.
- 1 (3¹/₂" x 21") Side Band.
- 2 (2¹/₄" x 14") Zipper Bands.
- 2 (3¹/₂" x 41/2") End Caps.
- 2 (3¹/₂" x 15") Side Bands.
- 2 (8" x 21") Base.

Assembly Construction method is the same!

- 6. Reduce presser foot pressure when sewing multiple layers.
- 7. Increase stitch length to 3–4 mm.
- 8. Double pin by using 2 rows of pinsthe first row every $1^{1/2}$ " along the seam line and a second row 1" to the left and parallel to the cut edge.
- 9. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.

10. Use an even-feed or walking foot, if possible. It makes a difference!
