- Felt tip marker or ballpoint pen
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Craft knife
- Micro-serrated scissors
- Long, flower head pins
- Fabric clips
- Point turner or chopstick
- Walking foot

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# Luxe Cuddle® **Pillow Sham**



## Luxe Cuddle<sup>®</sup> Pillow Sham

Approximate Finished Size: 20" x 27" Fits standard size bed pillows

#### DIRECTIONS

Read Cuddle® Basics before beginning.

**Right Side** Wrong Side

#### Cutting


1. Trim Luxe Cuddle<sup>®</sup> to: • 21" x wof\*.

#### Assembly


1. Fold over and pin  $\frac{1}{2}$ " along one selvedge. Hem with a wide (4x4mm) zigzag, serpentine, or straight stitch.




2. Draw a line on the wrong side of the fabric that is 6" from the opposite selvedge.




- 3. Starting with the fabric right side up, fold the hemmed edge up to the marked line. The right sides will be together.
- 4. Double pin (or fabric clip) along both side edges.




5. Sew on each side from the fold to the 6" mark. Backstitch at each end.





6. Following the marked line, fold the unhemmed selvedge over the hemmed edge to create a flap. Pin side seams of the flap. *Recommended: Pull the flap edge* 


(at the selvedge) outward about <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" before pinning and sewing. This *slight adjustment will make the* pillow fit just a bit more snugly.



### Cuddle<sup>®</sup> Basics

- 1. Seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{2}$  unless otherwise noted.
- 2. Mark measurements on wrong side of Cuddle® with a felt tip marker or ballpoint pen.
- 3. Cut with a rotary cutter, craft knife, or micro-serrated scissors.
- 4. Shake cut pieces or put in a no-heat dryer with a damp washcloth for a few minutes to remove loose fibers.
- 5. Sew with polyester thread in the top and the bobbin.

7. Sew the flap, using the previous seam as a guide.



#### Finishing

- 1. Turn pillow sham right side out.
- 2. Use a point turner or chopstick to gently push out the corners.
- 3. Insert pillow far enough to go under the flap on the inside of the pillow sham.

- 6. Reduce presser foot pressure when sewing multiple layers.
- 7. Increase stitch length to 3–4 mm.
- 8. Double pin by using 2 rows of pinsthe first row every  $1^{1/2}$ " along the seam line and a second row 1" to the left and parallel to the cut edge.
- 9. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.

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10. Use an even-feed or walking foot, if possible. It makes a difference!
