TIP SHEET

Self-Binding Your Quilt with Cuddle®


Have a beautiful pieced-cotton quilt top? Consider backing and self-binding it with Cuddle®—the ultimate in comfort. Create a 1" binding without having to cut strips!

Here's how:

Cut the batting and backing. Cut batting 2" wider on all sides than the outside pieced quilt edge (before it is quilted).

Cut backing 6" wider on all sides than the outside quilt edge.


2 Make a quilt sandwich. Quilt.

Smooth backing, wrong side up, on a flat surface. Center batting on backing.

Right side up, center quilt top on top. Spray baste the layers together.

Quilt on your domestic machine or on a longarm, as desired.

Do not trim.
